Once, when asked, Lahiri Mahasaya said that his 'Ishta Devata' (favorite deity as per hindu belief system) is 'Silence — stillness of the psyche-l'.

Music is a language that draws near to silence, a sound capable of evoking the soundless. It doesn't require meaning. Humans assign meaning to sounds, but when meaning is stripped away from sounds and replaced with harmony and rhythm that resonates with the heart, it can express the inexpressible. Music then says the unsayable without saying anything.

With this understanding, two beautiful stotras (chants) dedicated to Shibendu Baba were sung during the MahaKumbh retreat earlier this year. These stotras were composed by Kriyavans who are Sanskrit scholars, Dr. Amarnath Jha and Dr. Kashinath Nyupane. The purpose of this message is to share these stotras with the Kriyavan family, so they can be enjoyed individually or as part of chanting sessions in satsangs and retreats. Readers are reminded to focus on the harmony and rhythm of the sound, the meaning is incidental. Kriyavans Abhinav Ji and Kamakhya Ji have helped in writing this message.

This message is longer than usual as there was much to cover.
